Board Positions

President: Presides at all general and Board meetings, appoints chairpersons, oversees all FPA events, co-signs all checks, works closely with administration to establish goals, oversees room parents/room parent coordinators, etc.

Vice-President: Assists the President in all areas as needed, co-signs checks in absence of President or Treasurer, presides over campus general meetings in the absence of the President, etc.

Secretary: Takes minutes at all general meetings, assists in correspondence, maintains all files and records, etc.

Treasurer: Establishes and maintains bank accounts, reviews monthly reports and bank statements, co-signs all checks, reports on all bank accounts at Board and general meetings, etc.

Ways and Means: Oversees events and fundraisers throughout the school year, appoints chairpersons for social activities during the year, appoints chairpersons for other committees and/or fundraisers formed throughout the year, etc.
