

# UNIFORM GUIDELINES

Fairmont Private Schools enforces a uniform and appearance code. School is important work, and we expect students to dress as if they take school seriously. Fairmont students are required to wear True Grits school uniforms which are clean, pressed and in good condition. The Anaheim Hills campus dress code and appearance guidelines are listed below for your convenience.

### UNIFORM GUIDELINES:

#### 1. SHOES

**Daily wear** - Shoe colors should be in a hue matching the uniform, black or brown; shoestrings laced on top of the shoe (white or matching the shoe); no "light-up" shoes, combat boots or mules (backless shoes), please.  
**PE Shoes** - All students in grades 6 – 8 must wear athletic or tennis shoes for Physical Education.

#### 2. SOCKS

**Boys** – Cotton crew socks in a color complimentary to the uniform must be visible.  
**Girls** – Socks (must be visible or knee high) or tights (no lace or designs) must be white or navy blue in color.

#### 3. WALKING SHORTS

Shorts should be no more than 4 inches above the middle of the knee; kneecap must show.

#### 4. BELTS

A belt must be worn at all times; colors may be brown, black, khaki or navy (web or stretch).

#### 5. SHIRTS AND BLOUSES

Shirts and blouses must be tucked in.

#### 6. SKIRT LENGTH

Skirt hems should be no more than 4 inches above the knee.

#### 7. JACKETS/SWEATSHIRTS

Fairmont/True Grits jackets and sweatshirts only and a uniform shirt must be worn under the sweatshirt.

#### 8. SWEAT PANTS

Jr. High students may wear True Grits sweat pants for PE when it is cold or rainy.

#### 9. FIT

Clothing should fit properly; neither too large nor too tight.

#### 10. HAIR

Hair should have a conservative cut, natural color, no spikes, or shaved heads; hair should not touch the collar for boys.

#### 11. MAKE-UP AND LIPSTICK

No makeup for elementary students. Jr. High students, please refer to planner.

#### 12. NAIL POLISH

Clear, light colors.

#### 13. JEWELRY

**Earrings – Girls:** Stud or one half-inch loop only (limit one earring per ear).

**Earrings – Boys:** None

**Necklaces – Boys and girls:** "Fine" gold or silver chain with or without small pendant.

**Rings – Boys and girls:** Limit of two small rings per hand.

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## FREE DRESS DAY GUIDELINES:

1. The following guidelines apply on Free Dress Days:
  - Appropriate length of shorts and skirts
  - Appropriate fit of clothes
  - Rules regarding hair, make-up, and jewelry are the same as regular wardrobe
2. Shoes with closed heels and toes, of any color, may be worn
3. Pants or shorts of any color may be worn; blue jeans may be worn, but must be neat (no holes or cutoffs)
4. Scouts may wear their uniforms on any Scout meeting day
5. The following are all acceptable tops:
  - T-shirts, polo and oxford shirts of any color
  - Shirts and blouses with appropriate pictures, words or logos that do not advertise, represent or promote alcohol, drugs or tobacco products, violence, or anything of a sexual nature
6. The following are not acceptable tops:
  - Halter tops, tank tops or spaghetti straps
  - Crop tops or any shirt or blouse that exposes the midriff when the arms are lifted
  - Camouflage or combat garments, sun dresses, miniskirts, or tight fitting clothing are not allowed
  - No hats or caps

## PICTURE DAY WARDROBE:

### **Girls JK-3rd:**

White blouse (round collar/short sleeve); plaid jumper (4-pleat/drop waist).

### **Girls 4th- 8th:**

White, short sleeve, polo shirt (Jr. High will have green trim), skirt (4-pleat) or skort.

### **Boys JK - 8th:**

White, short sleeve, polo shirt (Jr. High will have green trim); pants or shorts with belt.
